Policy:

Pursuant to **Md. EDUCATION Code Ann. §16-106**, Cecil College will waive tuition only (not fees) on Maryland FTE eligible credit and certain non-credit courses to Maryland senior citizens, defined as Maryland residents 60 years of age and older, in alignment with Maryland state law. All waivers are subject to course eligibility requirements and space limitations.

Procedure:

1. Tuition charges for Maryland residents age 60+ are waived at the time of registration, as per Title 16 of the Annotated Code of Maryland for courses that are eligible for FTE by the Maryland Higher Education Commission.
2. Maryland residents age 60+ will pay all applicable fees, except for the student development fee, which will be waived.
3. Out-of-county Maryland residents age 60+ are exempt from out-of-county fees.
4. Out-of-state students age 60+ will be charged tuition and fees consistent with the College's published schedule.
5. Students age 60+ will be charged any additional fees adopted by the College, as appropriate.
6. Refunds to students age 60+ will follow current College policies.
