

Title: Admission of Gifted and Talented Students Policy

Policy:

Students under the age of 16 who have been identified as gifted and talented by the Director of Admissions or the Director of Early College and have a minimum GPA of 3.0 will be allowed to enroll in programs or credit courses at Cecil College where it has been determined that the student is academically prepared and will benefit from enrollment in college-level courses.

Procedure:

- 1) Student and family meets with Admissions personnel to review steps and forms for gifted and talented enrollment.
- 2) Student completes skills assessments and places at college level in the discipline of interest unless student is interested in a course that does not require an English or math pre-requisite.
- 3) Student completes admissions application and gifted and talented forms.
- 4) Student meets with Advising for registration purposes.
- 5) Faculty is contacted regarding the enrollment of a gifted and talented student.
- 6) Gifted and talented students may enroll in subsequent semesters after a mandatory meeting with an advisor.

Note: Gifted and talented students are subject to all College policies and procedures and Maryland State statutory provision §13B.07.02.01 of the Education Article.
